Since 2017, the Zoo and Aquarium All Hazards Partnership (ZAHP) has been able to provide a total of 43 small grants funded by the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) as a way to help enhance preparedness and response activities in the exotic animal industry (EAI).

DarkSide Ransomware: Best Practices for Preventing Business Disruption from Ransomware Attacks

In light of the recent DarkSide ransomware attack on a U.S. pipeline company, the Cybersecurity and Infrastructure Security Agency (CISA) and Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) have released a cybersecurity advisory, "DarkSide Ransomware: Best Practices for Preventing Business Disruption from Ransomware Attacks." CISA and FBI are urging critical infrastructure asset owners and operators to adopt a heightened state of awareness and implement the recommendations listed in this advisory.
