REMINDER: Endangered Species COVID-19 Relief **Applications Due Monday, November 1st!** The Association of Zoos and Aquariums (AZA) and the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service (FWS) have entered into a cooperative agreement to provide reimbursements to eligible facilities that cared for endangered and threatened species and rescued and confiscated wildlife and that experienced earned revenue losses as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic. Confirmation of COVID-19 in a Binturong, Fishing Cat, and Coatimundi

Recently, the USDA's National Veterinary Services Laboratories (NVSL) announced confirmation of SARS-CoV-2 in a binturong, fishing cat, and coatimundi at an Illinois Zoo.
