Zoonoses & One Health Updates (ZOHU) Calls are one-hour monthly webinars offered by the CDC that provide timely education on zoonotic and infectious diseases, One Health approaches, and more.

June's call will cover seroprevalence of SARS-CoV-2 among working dogs in Arizona, Zoonotic Influenza Reference Guide: Orientation to a new public health resource, and assessing carriers of pathogenic *Leptospira* species in the U.S. Virgin Islands and their risk to animal and public health.
